

## INVITATION FOR BIDS

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** by the President and Board of Trustees of the **VILLAGE OF EVERGREEN PARK**, Cook County, Illinois, that sealed bids will be received for the following improvement:

*2015 CDBG Sanitary Sewer Lining  
Community Development Block Grant No. 1507-013*

The proposed project consists of lining sanitary sewers with the cured-in-place pipe method.

Said bids will be received up to the hour of **10:15 A.M.** on the **23<sup>rd</sup> day of February, 2016** at the **Village of Evergreen Park, 9418 South Kedzie Avenue, Evergreen Park, Illinois 60805**, and will be publicly opened and read at **10:15 am**.

The bidding forms and documents are available at the office of **Frank Novotny and Associates, Inc., 545 Plainfield Road, Suite A, Willowbrook, Illinois, 60527, (Phone: 630/ 887-8640)**, upon payment of the sum of **One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00)**, which is not refundable. The Engineer has been authorized to refuse to issue Specifications and Proposals to any person, firm, or corporation that he or she considers to be unqualified. Proposals must be submitted on the forms provided. No Proposals will be issued to Bidders after **12:00 Noon** on the **19<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2016**. All proposals or bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond, Cash, or Certified Check made payable to the **Village of Evergreen Park** in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of the Proposal as a guarantee that if the Proposal is accepted, a Contract will be entered into and the performance of the Contract is properly secured.

No bid shall be withdrawn after the opening of the proposals without the consent of the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Evergreen Park for a period of **forty-five (45)** days after the scheduled time of closing bids.

The Bidder is specifically advised that the Village is a Subgrantee of the County of Cook of a grant made pursuant to the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended, pursuant to an agreement entered into and between the County of Cook and the Village of Evergreen Park. Payments to the Contractor will be made by the Village only after it has received the funds to make such payments from the County of Cook in accordance with the terms of the aforesaid agreement. Further, in compliance with the Stevens Amendment to the Department of Defense Appropriation Act of 1989, the estimated percentage of the total cost of this project to be funded with federal dollars is **SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT (75%)** and the exact dollar amount of federal funds which will be set aside for this project will be based on the contract amount awarded under this offering.

### APPLICABLE FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS

All laborers and mechanics employed by Contractor or Subcontractor(s) on construction work for this project shall be paid wages at rates not less than those prevailing on similar construction in the locality as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act as amended (U.S.C. 76-276a-5), and shall receive overtime compensation in accordance with and subject to the provisions of the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act (40 U.S.C. 327-333) and the Contractor and Subcontractor(s) shall comply with all regulations issued pursuant to these Acts and other applicable Federal laws and regulations pertaining to labor standards. The Secretary of Labor has, with respect to the labor standards specified in this Section, the authority and functions set forth in Reorganization Plan Number 14 of 1950 (5 U.S.C. 113z-15) and Section 2 of the Act of June 13, 1934, as amended (40 U.S.C. 276c).

The **Village of Evergreen Park** reserves the right to reject any and all Proposals or Bids.
