

Now residents have nice, open green space to bring their beloved pets to walk, exercise and "hang out" with their friends.

Each yard is secured, so you have no worries about your pet running out into a street, or dealing with bicyclists, walkers, joggers, etc. In short, Happy Bark Park is "for the dogs" !

Hours of Operation

Happy Bark Park is open seven days a week from 6am - 10pm. Entry is provided by way of an electronic keychain fob that can be purchased at the Village Hall.

Residents: \$20 for the first dog, \$5 each additional dog. Pets must be registered in the Village of Evergreen Park.

Non-Residents: \$50 for the first dog, \$10 each additional dog




Santa Visits Your House




