

EVERGREEN PARK POLICE NOTICE

COVID-19

March 17, 2020

The Evergreen Park Police Department requests your cooperation in implementing additional health prevention strategies to reduce the risk to the community and our employees during the COVID-19 crisis.

The Evergreen Park Police will only be responding to **high priority and emergency calls**, including but not limited to:

- Violent crimes and crimes against persons
- Domestic related incidents, either in progress or with the offender still on scene
- Incidents that require the collection of evidence
- Serious motor vehicle crashes
- Incidents that a Police Department Supervisor deems a Police Officer response is necessary

For **Low priority** calls; non-emergencies, minor property crimes, ordinance violations; we ask you to **call 911**. An Officer will be assigned the call and will call you back at the telephone number you provide.

We ask that you refrain from coming to the Evergreen Park Police Department to file a low priority incident report.

Please also refrain from coming to the Police Department if:

- You are experiencing flu like symptoms
- Traveled abroad within the last 14 days
