Large motor in the great room or outdoor when weather permits.

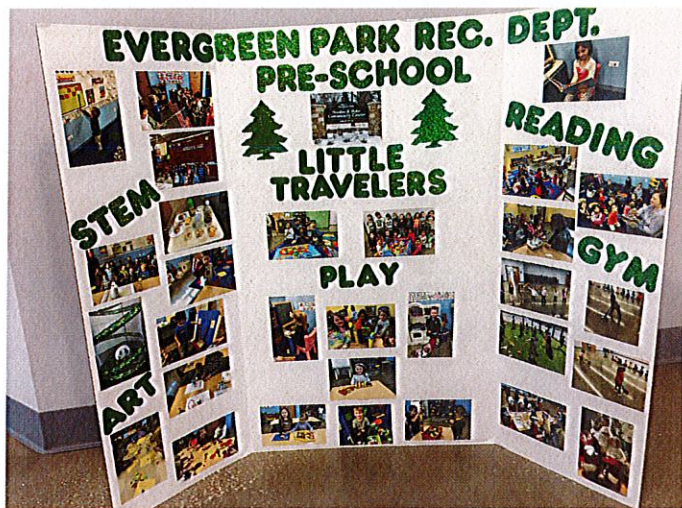
Pick up will begin at 11:25 am

The first day of preschool will be staggered, students with the last name A – L, 9:00 – 9:30 AM, and M – Z 10:00 – 10:30 AM.

Fall Preschool 2020–2021



Registration for fall preschool will continue until classes are filled or the session begins. Children who attend must be 3 years old and fully toilet trained by August 24, 2020. If your child turns 3 after August 24, call for 2nd session availability. To register for preschool you must provide the following items: the child's birth certificate, proof of residency, and a \$35.00 non-refundable deposit which

will be applied to the first preschool payment.

***If total tuition, (all 6 sessions) is paid in full before school begins, a 10% reduction will be applied.**

The preschool offers a curriculum that includes number, letter, word, color, and shape identification; arts & crafts; fine and gross motor skills; story time, playtime, and socialization. In addition, the 5 day program offers an introduction to countries around the world, science explorations, and extended math concepts.

All classrooms have 2 teachers; 1 or more are certified. All are CPR certified.
