VILLAGE OF EVERGREEN PARK ANNOUNCES L.E.A.D. EP INTERNSHIP

Evergreen Park, IL – The Village of Evergreen Park announced today the launch of a new summer internship, L.E.A.D. EP. The “L.E.A.D.” stands for Leadership, Excellence, Achievement and Distinction. The internship will provide students the opportunity to see how local government operates and provide training and resources to help them further their careers.

The L.E.A.D. EP internship program will work with four interns who are Evergreen Park residents and are either a graduating senior in high school or a freshman or sophomore in college. The internships are paid and participants will work 15-18 hours a week from June 13, 2022 through July 30, 2022.

“I have a strong interest in mentoring young people,” said Mayor Kelly Burke. “I believe in coaching and developing the smart, talented students we have here in Evergreen Park.”

Interns will learn about and work in multiple Village departments and functions and will have opportunities to go on local field trips and hear from guest speakers.

“We are excited to launch this internship program and help cultivate the future leaders of our community,” added Burke. “We have developed a program that encourages professional and personal growth for the participants and also shares the importance of understanding how local government works.”
