

Subject: COMMENDATION

I have been informed of your **Outstanding Performance of Duty** on June 6, 2018 at approximately 2300hrs. After receiving information regarding an Armed Robbery that had just occurred at the 7-11 store at 103rd and Sawyer Avenue, you observed a vehicle matching the description of a vehicle that was observed fleeing the scene with multiple occupants travelling E/B on 103rd St and turning N/B on Whipple Avenue. You initiated a felony stop and with assistance from multiple CPD units and detained the vehicle and its five occupants. A show up was conducted at the location of the stop and the occupants were identified by the victim as the offenders. Located inside the vehicle was a ski mask, handgun and U.S.C. Your immediate response and tactical approach to this situation showed great courage and extreme attention to your duty as a law enforcement professional. As a result of your actions, five violent offenders were removed from the street as well as the recovery of a handgun, evidence and the robbery proceeds. See I.R. #18-2883.
